Glenravel secured a semi-final berth in the U-14 Feile with a very impressive display against a well regarded Aldergrove team.

After conceding an early point Glenravel notched up 4-4 in a rampant first period. Niall Cushenan got the ball rolling with 5<sup>th</sup> minute clinker and this was followed by great goals from Declan Trainor, Karl Fitzpatrick and one direct from a Joseph Scullion free. In between there were great points from Karl Fitzpatrick, a highly impressive Gareth McKeown and 2 great long range efforts from Conor McNeill. During this period our defence held firm bolstered by the return of an excellent Jordan McNeill and an in-form Darren McLaughlin.

After the break Glenravel continued to dominate and, but for some over-elaborate play, would have added more to the final tally. A late 10 minute salvo by Phelim Duffin produced 2 points and a net-bursting goal and was followed up by a good point by Conor McNeill to leave the Con Mageas unbeaten this year.

This was Glenravel's best showing of the season so far. Our defence kept the opposition scoreless in the second half and, to a man, they produced a great display of committed tackling, continually robbing possession from Aldergrove. Our no-nonsense full-back line broke down attack after attack with the half backs collecting and setting up good ball for the forwards.
