Our run in the Feile sadly came to an end last Sunday in Rasharkin. Up against a more physical Dunloy team we succumbed to the poor conditions and their "win at all costs" play.

We won the toss and elected to play with the gale force wind in the first half. However, good tactical work from Dunloy meant we were unable to exploit the wind and we were pinned in our own half for most of the 20 minutes. We were sound defensively but unable to clear the ball effectively. For reasons still unknown the referee decided to present Dunloy with a penalty that resulted in the only points of the first half.

With the wind advantage over and a goal behind, it was obvious that the second half was going to be very difficult. However, from the throw in we raced up the field and drove the ball to the Dunloy net. This was just the tonic and it seemed we had them on the backfoot. Unfortunately, the referee again intervened to disallow the goal giving a square ball. A five minute period of sustained Dunloy pressure where we were again unable to clear our lines resulted in three points for them. But again we rallied and spirits were lifted when we grabbed a goal. Unfortunately, Dunloy again found the net but we responded with a goal before they grabbed another. However Glenravel did not give up and through the poorest conditions we had our longest period of pressure but we were unable to find any more scores. The disappointment was obvious at the end and we were left with lots to think about. There were some good performances throughout. The backline of Ronan, Neil and Connor McKeown stood firm under constant pressure, Connor McNeill was the driving force at midfield and again, every time Declan Trainor ran with the ball, Dunloy panicked. In fact, every time he got the ball, the Dunloy manager ran down the line shouting at his players to pull him down. Unfortunately we did not get the ball to Declan enough.

It was great to see a good turnout to support us and I am sure everyone would agree that the referee and Dunloy's bullying tactics contributed to our downfall. However, this is still a good football team and we can only improve as the year goes on.
